Today’s Music: Dr. Brian Wren wrote the hymn, “Deep in the Shadows of the
Past” in September 1973. He drew upon James Barr’s *The Bible in the Modern
World* (1973), where the author states that “The Bible [is] the ‘classic model’ of
and for the Christian faith.”

The hymn was first published in *New Church Praise* (1975), a hymnal
supplement of the United Reformed Church in England and Wales. Dr. Wren
writes, “Changes were made to this first text with a conscious effort to affirm
inclusive language and to simplify and make stronger different expressions and
words.”

Dr. Wren says the hymn “tells the story of the Bible in a manner acceptable
to different beliefs about its inspiration.” In an address given in 1985 at a
workshop at Chicago Theological Seminary, he said, “A good contemporary
hymn, however, will delight the imagination, express our faith and our seeking,
and be honest enough to express what people *really* know, ask, fear, and
experience – not what we think we ought to feel and say.” (From UMC
