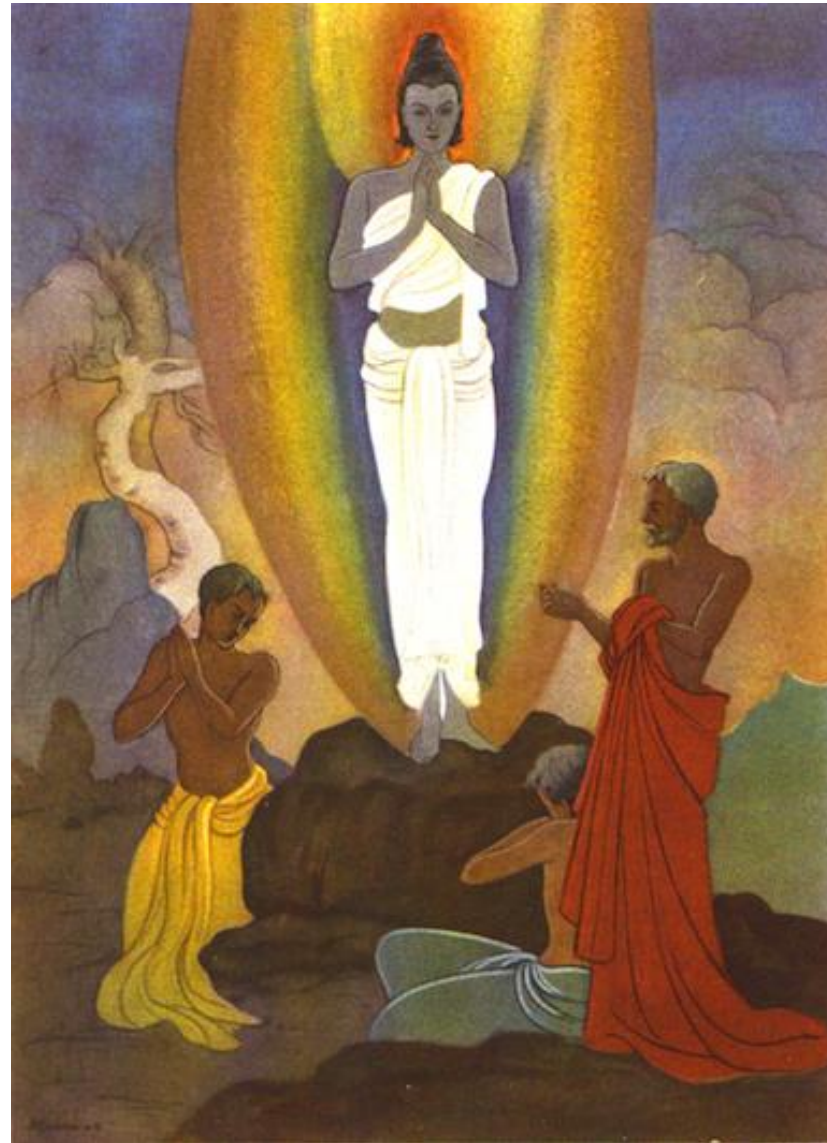

Today’s Music: Edward H. Plumptre is the author of “Rejoice Ye Pure in Heart.” It was written as a processional for the 1865 Peterborough Choir Festival at the Peterborough Cathedral in England. Plumptre published it in his *Lazarus and Other Poems* in 1865 or 1868. Its first inclusion in a hymnal was in the *Appendix to Hymns Ancient and Modern* in 1868. MARION is the most common tune used with this text. It was written for Plumptre’s text in 1883 by Arthur H. Messiter, who added the refrain. Messiter published the tune in a hymnal that he edited in 1893. The tune was named by the composer, but it is not clear for whom it was named.
