Today’s Music: “Come, We That Love the Lord” was a favorite hymn of singing  
schools throughout early American hymnody and was matched with multiple  
different tunes as late as 1857. In the twentieth century, as gospel hymns  
became more accepted, Watts’ text was able to be matched with “Marching to  
Zion,” a favorite of Sunday School, revival, and African American worship  
experiences.
