Hymnic Notes: The processional includes portions of a paraphrase of the thirteen articles of the Jewish creed called the *Yigdal* or doxology. The tune, LEONI, is named after Meyer Lyon (1751-1797) known as Leoni, the chief musician of London's Great Synagogue. The melody is common to Jewish, Spanish-Basque, and Russian folk traditions, and was used by Bedrich Smetana in his orchestral masterpiece *Vltava (The Moldau)*, 1874.

The recessional is a reminder that God is ready to forgive, gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love (Nehemiah 9:17b). *(Hymnic Notes by Carlton Young)*

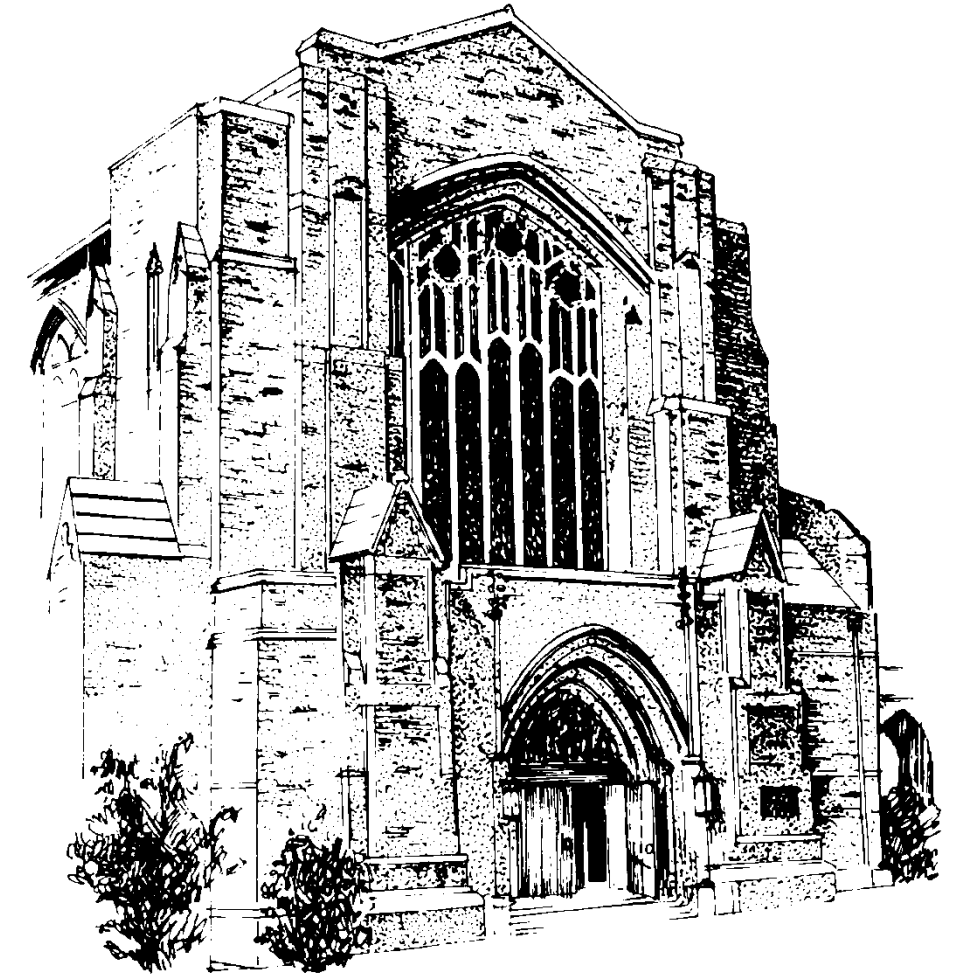
