Hymnic Notes: The processional consists of six of Watts’ original nine-stanza paraphrase of Psalm 90:1-5 titled ‘Man Frail, and God Eternal.’ John Wesley altered the opening, ‘Our God,’ to ‘O God.’ The hymn was matched with the tune ST. ANNE in 1814. The composer, William Croft, was well known during his life as one of England’s foremost composers of music for the church. His musical setting of the Anglican funeral service is still used for Royal memorial services today.

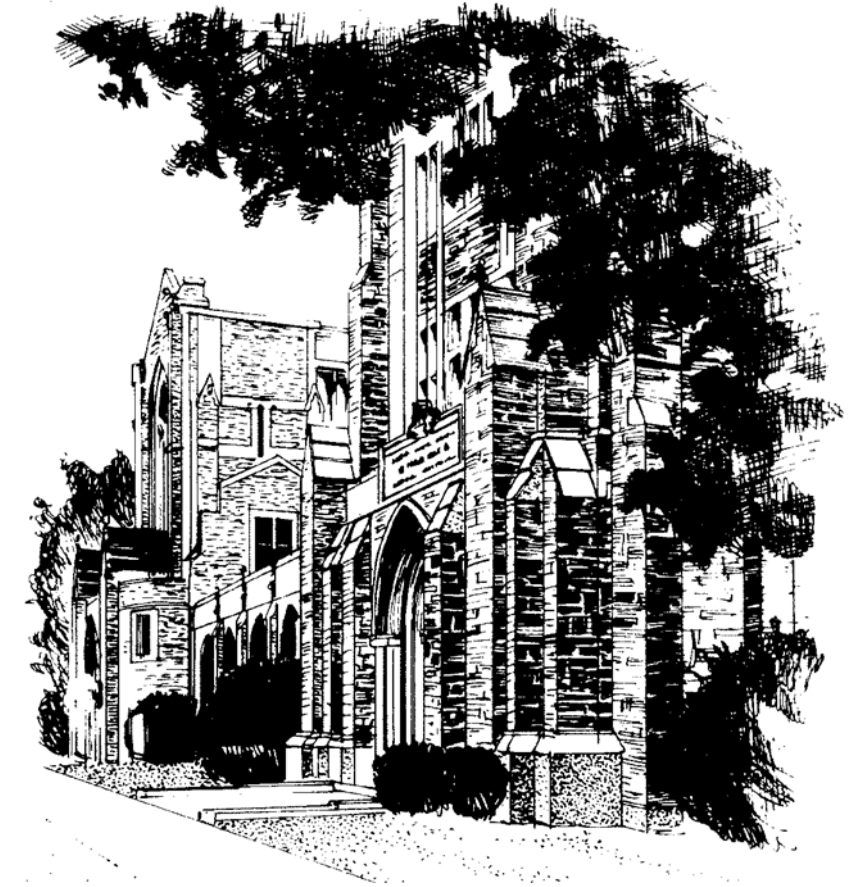
