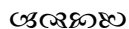

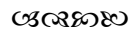

Joshua Coble is a native of Huntsville, Alabama and earned the doctor of musical arts in organ performance at The University of Alabama. Coble earned a master of music in church music and organ performance from Samford University, and a bachelor of arts degree in organ performance from the University of Alabama in Huntsville. In 2007 Coble placed first in the Alabama Federation of Music Clubs' scholarship auditions, and placed second in the 2010 University of Alabama Organ Scholarship Competition. He was also the recipient of the Warren Hutton Endowed Scholarship in Organ. Joshua has participated in national organ competitions including the Arthur Poister Scholarship Competition in Organ Playing and was an Official Competitor in the 2014 National Young Artists Competition in Organ Performance. Joshua has studied organ

with Donald Sutherland, Faythe Freese and Daniel Lawhon. He has taught as instructor of organ at The University of Alabama, Tuscaloosa and currently teaches at Belmont University in Nashville as adjunct-instructor of organ and church music. Coble serves as Assistant Director of Music and Organist at First United Methodist Church in Montgomery, Alabama. Prior to this appointment he was organist for nine years at Mountain Brook Baptist Church in Birmingham and also served as Associate Organist at Brentwood United Methodist Church in Nashville.
