Hymnic Notes: The hymn tune, Morecambe, was written in 1870 by Frederick Atkinson as a setting of the famous hymn "Abide with Me." It was first published in 1887 and takes its name from a coastal town on the Morecambe Bay near Lancaster, England. This was close to the town of Bradford where Atkinson worked as an organist. The tune is mostly associated now with "Spirit of God, Descend Upon my Heart," the hymn we sing at the conclusion of the service today.
