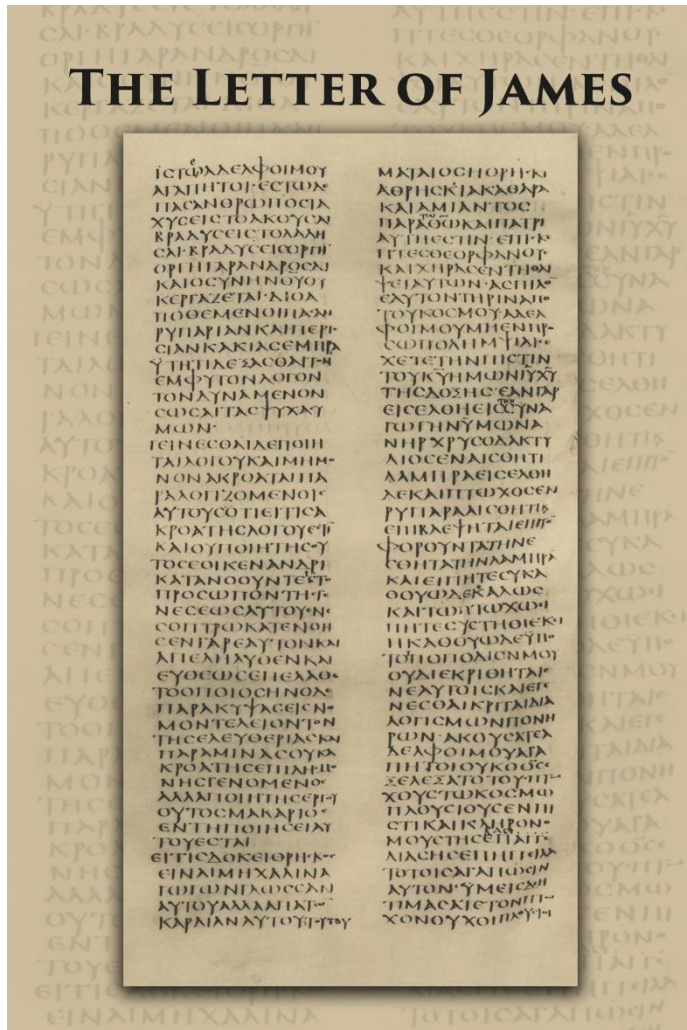

ability. We believe God loves everyone unconditionally!*

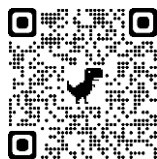
