#### **Today's Music**

In the mid-nineteenth century, Bishop John William Colenso of Natal raised a ruckus in the Catholic Church by challenging the historicity and authority of many of the Old Testament books. Bishop Gray of Capetown wrote a stirring response of defense, which, in 1866, inspired Samuel Stone, to write "The Church's One Foundation," basing his text on Article 9 of the Apostle's Creed: "The Holy Catholic (Universal) Church; the Communion of Saints; He is the Head of this Body."

#### **Bulletin Cover Art**

"Red Vineyards at Arles" was created in 1888 by the famous Dutch artist, Vincent van Gogh. This was among around 860 oil paintings created by van Gogh in the last two years of his life and bears the brush strokes that make his art very identifiable.


#### **REGIONAL MISSION TRIP TO SAGER BROWN**


